Contributions of Scions for Scion Exchanges

You can print these labels and tape them to your bags, or print them on self-adhesive Avery label sheets. Please also include the variety's chill hours and whether or not the variety is self-pollinating, (this can be googled). Scions of unknown/unmarked varieties will not be accepted.

When sealing the bag, spritz with one spray of water or a few drops of water, (no paper towel needed as this can cause mold) and store in the fridge until you bring them to the exchange.
